

FITTING BEAK BITS

Not designed to be a permanent fixture on your hen, beak bits can be useful for breaking the habit of feather pecking or egg eating. Leave on for a couple of months.

It is a 2 person job and requires the bird to be held firmly.



- Use a pair of Circlip pliers to open the beak bit.
- Holding the hen, open her beak and place the beak bit in the mouth.
- Place the two clips very gently into the nostrils and ensure you are **not** pinching the outer skin. The clips go under the skin flaps and rest against the hens septum.
- If it is not correctly fitted she will be able to remove it.
